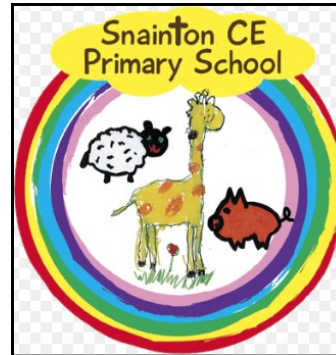


WELCOME

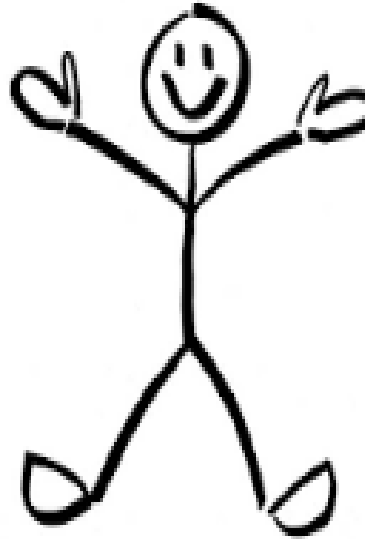
