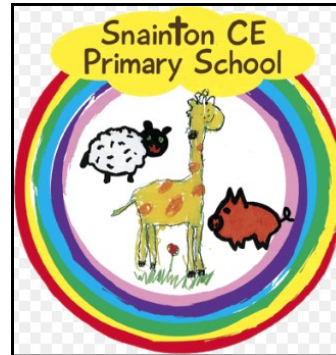


# WELCOME

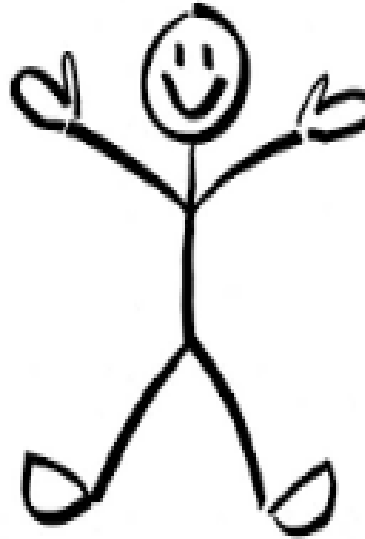


The winner was Graham Newlove who won £19.00.
