Welcome to our third newsletter—this term is already moving at a fast pace! The children have settled well in to their new class really well and are showing a good attitude to learning.


I look forward to welcoming as many people as possible to school for the Macmillan coffee morning next week. Please feel free to invite any family members that would like to visit.


