Easter Egg Competition

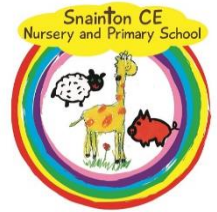
We will be holding an "Best Decorated Easter Egg" competition in school next week.

Parking

We have received a complaint from a local resident in relation to parents parking on the solid white line near to the junction and the dangers of this. They have said that if they feel that this is not dealt with they will take matters further.

Please can all parents/carers who use cars to get their children to and from school consider where they park their car. It must be considerate, safe and legal.

Parking too near a corner

Parking near junctions (Rule 243 of the Highway Code) 'DO NOT stop or park opposite or within 10 metres (32 feet) of a junction, except in an authorised parking space'.

Cars parked too close to a junction prevent other drivers from having a clear view

Cars parked too close to the junction often cause other cars to creep out towards the centre of the road putting themselves and other drivers at risk of collision.

Parking near solid white lines

Avoid parking at points on a road where you can see a solid white line. The white line indicates a hazard with:

Parking near a dropped kerb

Parking opposite yellow zig zag line

Parking on the brow of a hill

Parking near a bend

Parking in front of resident's drives

If a vehicle is seen not adhering to this then their vehicle details will be passed onto the police. We need to ensure our children's safety.
