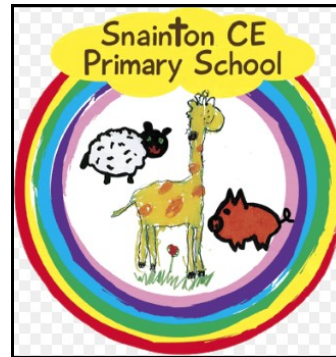


WELCOME

No one should have a negative balance. If you would like a balance of your account or any assistance with parent pay Mrs Mathewson would be more than happy to help.

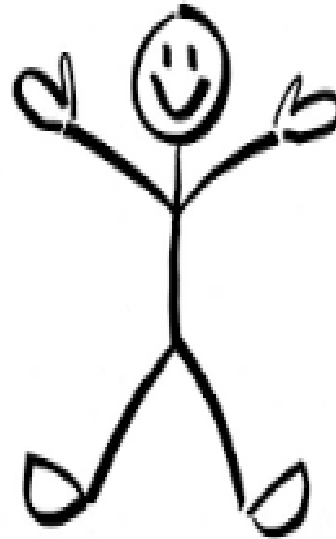
