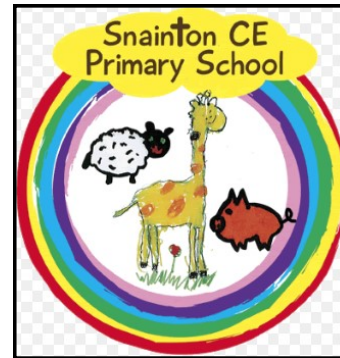


# WELCOME
