### Oak Class

Our topic this term in Oak class is "Toys". We have been looking at stories that are dedicated to toys, these include 'The Teddy Robber' we made a collage giant related to the story. This week we have been reading 'The Velveteen Rabbit', we have made our own rabbits out of different materials, paper plate rabbits and baked cheesy rabbits. This is to show all toys come in different shapes and sizes and can be made from different materials but all are special to us.

### Maple Class

Maple class has been learning about different materials and investigating why paper is not often used to make toys. We learnt about how paper is made and used a fun drama activity to re-enact the process of cutting the tree down, transporting it to the factory, taking the bark off, chipping the wood, cooking it to make a paste, flattening the paper and drying it out. Since then, the children have been very good at recycling used paper in our classroom.

### Silver Birch Class

Silver Birch have been learning about Poland this week in Geography. We have looked at the Polish paper cutting art work called wycinanki and practised creating our own designs. For science we have been looking at forces, the children loved launching their parachutes and teddies from Mrs Roberts' window as we explored air resistance.
