

### History

410-1066

- The Anglo-Saxons were of Germanic descent, ruling and inhabiting modern day England and Wales from the 5th Century AD until the Norman Conquest in 1066.
- Accounts from St. Bede the Venerable state that the Angles, Saxons and Jutes came to Britain to help the Picts and the Scots in the void left after the Romans left.
- The settlements lay the foundations for the kingdoms of Essex, Sussex, Wessex (Saxons), East Anglia, Middle Anglia, Mercia, Northumbria (Angles) and Kent (Jutes).
- Each of the Anglo-Saxon Kingdoms spoke distinctive dialects – these evolved over time to become known as Old English.
